How is the Lenten Season going for you? For your TEC Community?

Sometimes Lent conjures up for me thoughts of radical change, invitation to sacrificing, 40 days of fasting...all the things I learned about as a boy in Catholic school.

Things have changed so much since those 50s and 60s that took me through grade school, high school and early college. Lent is still the same, but the way we connect now is certainly different. We have cell phones, Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn as ways of communicating instantly and with large numbers of people. More ways of connecting arrive each season. But the only way to connect with God is with a personal decision. Jesus knew he belonged to God. Do we?

Look at but a few of the scripture readings that have been a part of the season of Lent.

- 2 Corinthians 5:20-6:2; Matthew 6:1-6, 16-18 - Ash Wednesday
- Luke 4:1-13 (c, 2010) - First Sunday in Lent
- Ezekiel 18:21-28; Matthew 5:20-26 - Friday of the first full week of Lent
- Luke 9:28b-39 - Second Sunday of Lent
- Genesis 37:3-4, 12-13a, 17b-28a; Matthew 21:33-43, 45-46 - Friday second week of Lent
- Luke 13:1-9 - Third Sunday of Lent
- Hosea 6:1-6; Mark 12:28-34 - Friday in the third week of Lent
- Luke 15:1-3, 11-32 - Fourth Sunday of Lent

- Isaiah 49:8-15; John 5:17-30 - Wednesday of the fourth week of Lent

What powerful and inviting readings we have been blessed with to assist me in renewing my spiritual life, to stop and think about what is going on inside me. It is time to reconsider who Jesus is for me and to renew my faith from the inside out.

In each of the readings above, plus those not listed, there have been key words and phrases that give us a sense of hope, a clearer perspective on what truly matters, and how we are to conduct our lives and the life of our TEC Community.

Here are a few of those words/phrases:

- Pray - Fast - Share
- Embrace - Serve - Celebrate
- Ask - Knock
- Listen - Praise - Let Yourself be loved
- Change - Forgive
- Receive - Discern - Connect

What do they say to me, to each of us and to our TEC Community?

Lent is a journey of the whole heart, a time to cultivate our relationship with the Sacred One and embrace the daily experiences of one's life with a conviction that grace is unfolding in each moment.

Enjoy the last two weeks of Lent and get ready for the great celebration of Easter.
