Conference offers three-day training event for TEC leaders

ST. LOUIS — The TEC Conference, in conjunction with Spirit of St. Louis TEC, is holding a Communities of Faith and Follow-Through (CF&F) Workshop, June 8-10 at St. Francis Borgia Regional High School in Washington, Mo. The three-day training event focuses on the vital role each TEC adult faith community plays in ministering to Catholic youth and young adults before, during and after the TEC weekends.

Through Eucharist, prayer, round table discussions and multimedia presentations, workshop participants will gain the resources to: more effectively minister to the young people in their diocese; become prayerful and discerning TEC leaders; build partnerships both within their diocese and with other ministries, and live the Gospel and Paschal Mystery spirituality more powerfully.

The TEC Conference Spirituality Committee developed the workshop in 2004, in response to the requests of local leaders who wanted additional training. Since then, nine workshops have been held in dioceses across the United States.
