TEC to hold June workshop for group spiritual directors

TEC, a Catholic movement of spirituality for older adolescents and young adults, will hold a workshop for TEC spiritual directors next month.

The workshop will take place Monday-Thursday, June 25-28, at the LaSalle Retreat Center in Wildwood. It is sponsored by the TEC Conference, the guiding body of the TEC movement, and its spirituality committee. Its offices are in Festus.

The event will outline the theology behind TEC and give participants a chance to collaborate with leaders from TEC's 67 faith communities in 60 dioceses in North America and Europe. The workshop is open to priests, religious, deacons and laity who serve as TEC spiritual directors.

Featured speakers are Archbishop Roger L. Schweiz, OMI, head of the Archdiocese of Anchorage, Alaska, episcopal moderator for the TEC movement; TEC founder Father Matthew Fedewa of St. Paul, Minn.; Father James Brown, OAR, of Oxnard, Calif., who helped to develop a manual that outlines the structure of how TEC operates; and TEC Conference spiritual director Sister Jacque Schroeder, OSF, of Peoria, Ill.

Attendees also will participate in multimedia presentations, prayer and roundtable discussions and join together for Mass as they explore what it means to be a spiritual director in the TEC movement.

Participants also will look at TEC in light of the liturgical and sacramental life of the Church through presentations on Paschal Mystery spirituality, TEC and youth ministry, presenting the Paschal Mystery to young people and TEC as an evangelizing community.


Cost for the workshop is \$200, which includes workshop materials, lodging and meals. Registration deadline is Friday, June 15.
